With an estimated 8,308,369 residents in 2012, London is the most populous region, urban zone and metropolitan area in the United Kingdom.

Standing on the River Thames, London has been a major settlement for two millennia, its history going back to its founding by the Romans, who named it Londinium.

Progress

London is a leading global city, with strengths in the arts, commerce, education, entertainment, fashion, finance, healthcare, media, professional services, research and development, tourism and transport all contributing to its prominence.



Financial Centre

It is one of the world's leading financial centres and has the fifth- or sixth-largest metropolitan area GDP in the world depending on measurement.



Cultural Capital

London has been described as a world cultural capital. It is the world's most-visited city as measured by international arrival and has the world's largest city airport system measured by passenger traffic.



Education and Sport

London's 43 universities form the largest concentration of higher education in Europe. In 2012, London became the first city to host the modern Summer Olympic Games three times.

- ✓ the site comprising the Palace of Westminster, Westminster Abbey, and St Margaret's Church;
- ✓ the historic settlement of Greenwich.
